Hunting Hawk Golf Association is pleased to announce the schedule and information for our 2023 season. The Saturday tournament schedule will be made up of 8 events and our Summer Series tournament schedule will have 10 events.

Member Benefits:

- Establish a handicap through the VSGA/USGA
- Eligible to play in RGA & VSGA events
- Monthly golf tournaments for HHGA Members Only
- Eligible to participate in Inter-club Matches

Event Information:

- Players are asked to check in at least 30 minutes before tee time / starting time.
- Players are responsible for paying golf fees per round (\$60 with cart on tournament days only) if you are not a club member. Members must pay \$20 cart fee. Players MUST RIDE during all association events.
- Players will play the Black Tees, Seniors age 60-69 will play White Tees and Super Seniors age 70+ Gray Tees. Seniors with a course handicap of 7 from the black tees will play Black Tees.
- Championship Flight will play the Talon tees in the Club Championship and Match Play Championship.
- Players will not be allowed to choose who they play with in tournaments. Players will be randomly placed into groups and we will try to move the pairings around.
- All members must have an established Handicap to play in association events.
- Sign-up sheet will be posted in Pro Shop two weeks prior to date of event.
- USGA Rules govern all play.
- Prizes are awarded per event in the value of gift certificates that can be used in the pro shop for merchandise only.

Important Notice:

- Players that do not show for their tee time on events days will not be allowed to play in the following event. We will require that you notify us by phone or email no later than 6:00pm the night before if you are not playing in the tournament.
- Players will also not be able to play in the next event for an unjustified withdrawal from an event.

The “Hawk Cup”:

Going into the 2023 season the Hawk Cup format will go unchanged other than the number of Hawk Cup Tournaments dropping from six to four. During the 4 regular season events, players will earn points based on their final standings in each tournament. The final tournament standings will be done in a Net Division with each player receiving 75% of his handicap. The “Hawk Cup” events are listed on the tournament schedule with an (*HC*) next to the event name. In the event of any ties, players will receive the same amount of points.

There will be bonus points that you can receive during the season by simply playing in the events. You will receive 10 bonus points per non- Hawk Cup event that you play in during the regular season, and you can also earn 10 points by playing in Summer Series events with a 25 point bonus for playing in five.

Take advantage of these bonus opportunities which could help you make the Top 12!

At the conclusion of our season, we will have our Hawk Cup Championship which is a now a one-day, individual competition for the Top 12 players in the Hawk Cup Standings. The Hawk Cup Champion will be the individual that has the lowest handicap score for the Hawk Cup Championship. The winner will receive “The Hawk Cup” along with a ***FREE One Year Full Golf Membership*** to Hunting Hawk Golf Club that is valid for 2024 season and begins on January 1st.

Membership Dues:

Any current HHGA Member that brings in a new player that joins the Association will receive a free round of golf at Hunting Hawk that can be used during an event or at their own leisure. There is no limit on how many rounds you can receive, so start recruiting!!

Off Saturday Group:

Any member of the Hunting Hawk Golf Association is able to play in the Off Saturday Group which takes place on non-event Saturday mornings. The group will play a two player blind draw with a Stableford Format. This does involve a \$15 fee to take part in the game, skins and closest to the pins. **Non-HHGA Members will only be invited to play if there are openings available which will be known in the final 24 hours before the scheduled round.** Off Saturday tee times will be limited to 5 tee times.

2023 Tournament Schedule: 10am to 11am Tee Time Start Unless Noted

April 22 – Dust the Rust Scramble

Teams formed by computer (ABCD). Teams will play a four person Captain's Choice with scoring being done by overall gross.

May 6 – Spring Championship (*HC*) *Possible Earlier Start*

Individual stroke play. Players will be flighted by handicap. Gross scores only.

June 3 – Four Player Team Championship

Teams formed by computer (ABCD). Best two balls gross. Teams will use a preferred drive format and then play their own ball until holing out.

June 24 – The Memorial Tournament (*HC*)

Individual stroke play. Players will be flighted by handicap. Gross scores only.

July 8 – Two Player Team Championship

Created your own two player team. Best ball gross and net used for scoring.

July 29 – Member/Member (Scramble / Best Ball / Modified Alt)

Create your own two player team. Players will play a Scramble on holes 1-6, a best ball on holes 7-12 and a modified alternate shot on holes 13-18. Field will be flighted.

August 19 – Club Championship (*HC*)

18 hole individual stroke play. Players will be flighted by handicap. Gross scores only. Championship Flight – Two Day Championship (August 19-20)

September 23 – Fall Championship (*HC*)

Individual stroke play. Players will be flighted by handicap. Gross scores only.

2023 Other Events:

Begins June 19 – Match Play Championship

Individual match play competition. Players will be flighted by handicap.

October 7 – Hawk Cup Championship (9:00am)

Individual stroke play competition for the Top 12 in the Hawk Cup Standings.

October 21 – The Battle at Hunting Hawk (Team Jeff vs. Team Smitty) (Top 22 & Four Wild Cards in Final Hawk Cup Standings)

Team Match Play competition. 27 hole competition.

December 4 – End of Season Party

2023 Summer Series (9-Hole Events): Shotgun start times in RED.

April 12 – Bring A Friend Scramble - (5:30pm)

Two player scramble with one player being a non HHGA member. You can play with another HHGA member but we recommend bringing someone else.

April 26 – Two Man Blind Draw - (5:45pm)

Two player best ball with the two man teams being created by blind draw. Scoring will be done by best ball net with players receiving 75% off their 9-hole handicap.

May 17 – Four Player Step-Aside Scramble - (5:45pm)

Four player teams will be created by computer. Your team will play a four player Captain's Choice, with the same player not being able to have their shot used in a row.

May 31 – Par 3 Challenge - (5:45pm)

Individual stroke play. All holes will be Par 3's. Field will be flighted by handicap.

June 14 – Individual Strokeplay - (5:45pm)

Individual stroke play. Gross scores only. Field will be flighted by handicap.

June 28 – Four Player Yellow Ball - (5:45pm)

Four player teams will be created by computer. Three players will play their own ball while one player plays the yellow ball. Don't lose it!

July 12 – Alternate Shot - (5:45pm)

Two player team event. Players will both hit tee balls, select the best ball and alternate until the hole is completed.

July 19 – Ladies Night / Bring A Friend Par 3 Challenge - (5:45pm)

Two player team event. All holes will be Par 3's. Field flighted by handicap. There will be two divisions, one for ladies night and one for friend night.

August 2 – Two Player Best Ball - (5:45pm)

Create your own two player team. Players will play their own ball with best ball gross and net counting per hole.

August 23 – Individual Stroke Play (Red Tees) - (5:30pm)

Individual stroke play from the Red Hawk Tees. Net scores will be used for scoring.
